

Reporting of suspect •No case to Maine CDC Required To Submit •No Laboratory Specimen •Information on requisition must include: test requested, patient name, DOB, date of collection, specimen source or type, submitter name and contact information. Required Information •Important: all specimens must be labeled with patient name, DOB or other unique identifier, and be accompanied by a HETL requisition. • Cerebral Spinal Fluid (CSF) (0.5ml minimum, 1ml preferred) or serum (at least 0.5mL). •Samples should be kept at 2-8°C for short term storage and may be frozen (-70°C) for long term Specimen Requirements storage. Collect specimen in a sterile leak proof container. • Respiratory: Nasopharyngeal swab, Throat swab, Nasal wash •DO NOT DILUTE CSF. Do not use viral transport media (VTM). • Respiratory specimens should be submitted in VTM or other appropriate media. **Collection Instructions** • Ship specimens on frozen ice packs and transport to lab as soon as possible. • Do not freeze/thaw • Results are generally available within 1 - 3 business days of specimen receipt Turn Around Time • Specimens received without a form and clinical details or with insufficient material to analyze.
