- Considers the performance of the state system by considering these questions:
 - What are the components, activities, competencies, and capacities of our public health system?
 - How well are the Essential Services being provided in our system?
- Through a facilitated process that encourages dialogue, it can
 - ✤ Identify strengths and weaknesses within the system.
 - Discuss opportunities to improve and better coordinate public health activities .
 - Provide a better understanding of the state public health system's performance.
 - Facilitate informed, effective policy and resource decisions.

Planning for Next SPHSA in 2025

- What was the process in 2021?
 - Members of SCC and MPHA formed committee in 2019
 - Method of Delivery: started as in-person, moved to virtual
 - Facilitation Team
 - Logistics and IT Team
 - Scripted and Timed
 - Rehearsed and Piloted prior to first session
 - Conducted virtually on August 10, 11, 12 and 17, 18, 19, 2021

Ten Essential Public Health Services Pre-2021 Version

- 1. Monitor health status to identify state health problems.
- 2. Diagnose and investigate health problems and health hazards in the state.
- 3. Inform, educate, and empower people about health issues.
- 4. Mobilize state partnerships to identify and solve health problems.
- 5. Develop policies and plans that support individual and state health efforts.
- 6. Enforce laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
- 7. Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable.
- 8. Assure a competent public health and personal health care workforce.
- 9. Evaluate effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal and population-based health services.
- 10. Research for new insights and innovative solutions to health problems.

Ten Essential Public Health Services Post-2021 Version

- 1. Assess and monitor population health status, factors that influence health, and community needs and assets
- 2. Investigate, diagnose, and address health problems and hazards affecting the population.
- 3. Communicate effectively to inform and educate people about health, factors that influence it, and how to improve it.
- 4. Strengthen, support, and mobilize communities and partnerships to improve health.
- 5. Create, champion, and implement policies, plans, and laws that impact health.
- 6. Utilize legal and regulatory actions designed to improve and protect the public's health.
- 7. Assure an effective system that enables equitable access to the individual services and care needed to be healthy.
- 8. Build and support a diverse and skilled public health workforce.
- 9. Improve and innovate public health functions through ongoing evaluation, research, and continuous quality improvement.
- 10. Build and maintain a strong organizational infrastructure for public health.
