## Footnotes

1. Fully evaluate for TB Disease: Complete physical examination, order tests to determine Latent TB Infection or TB disease. Tests for TB disease could include a chest X- Ray, sputum samples, and additional tests based on presentation of symptoms.

2. Complete full treatment course for LTBI: Treatment that prevents the progression of infection into TB disease. Clinicians should choose the appropriate treatment regimen based on drug susceptibility results of the presumed source case (if known), coexisting medical conditions (e.g.,<u>HIV</u>), and potential for drug-drug interactions.

3. No further evaluation or treatment required: Latent TB Infection and TB Disease are not likely.
