Original publication: February 14, 1997

Modified May 1997 per BMS request to break out Bladder and Bowel Incontinence; also removed bowel criteria from QI106;

Modified June 1997 to include suggestions on Cognitive Impairment –Created new indicator to reflect modified cognition (*Memory recall skills section (B2) removed because it was felt this inaccurately assessed the residents' actual abilities since much is learned through habit*)

And

Falls – Removed falls from the injury indicator and created separate indicator for falls from 23 May 97 BMS QI Meeting;
