This service combines community support and case management with primary care. Behavioral health providers partner with primary care providers to better manage your care.

MaineCare's Behavioral Health Homes:

Are voluntary - you join only if you want to.

Offer a team approach where care coordination, case management, peer and family supports, and other services work with primary care.

Can take the place of the community support services you receive now.

May already be offered by your or your child's community support provider. Talk to your case manager or community support provider to find out more.
