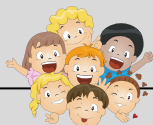


Get help with Affordable Health Care Coverage for kids



If your child does not have health insurance, they may qualify for Cub Care, which provides comprehensive coverage with a low-cost monthly fee.

Cub Care is a health insurance option through MaineCare that provides quality health insurance for children under age 19 who earn up to 208% of the Federal Poverty Level, which is \$4,704 a month for a family of four*.



Cub Care covers doctors visits, hospitalizations, dental visits, transportation, medications, behavioral health services, and more.

After you apply, you will receive a Notice of Decision in the mail when a decision has been made about your application. If you qualify, your child's Cub Care coverage begins the first day of the application month.
