Quality Measures

Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits for Health Homes (HH) and Behavioral Health Homes (BHH)

MaineCare members 3-21 years of age who have had one or more comprehensive well-care visit during the current measurement year

Screening for the metabolic side effects of antipsychotic medication for BHH: Pay-for Performance (P4P)

MaineCare members who had two or more fills of antipsychotic medication and who have had at least one hemoglobin A1c or fasting blood glucose test in the measurement year

Technical Support and Quality Improvement Activities

MaineCare Value-Based Purchasing Quality Measure: Child and Adolescent Well Care Visits (WCV)



Eligible Population

MaineCare Health Home and Behavioral Health Home members, 3–21 years of age, with no more than a one-month gap in MaineCare eligibility during the measurement period



Service Provided

At least one comprehensive well-care visit with a PCP or an OB/GYN practitioner during the measurement year that includes:

- A health history
- Physical Exam
- Physical and mental development history
- Anticipatory guidance

One or more well-visits in the measurement year

MaineCare Value-Based Purchasing Pay-for-Performance Measure: Screening For the Metabolic Side Effects of Antipsychotic Medication (P4P)



Eligible Population

MaineCare Behavioral Health Home members with two or more fills of an antipsychotic medication during the measurement period



Service Provided

At least one Hemoglobin Glycosylated (HbA1c) or Fasting Blood Glucose (FBG) test during the measurement year
