

Summary Report of COVID-19 Assessments: Assisted Living Facilities (6/3/20)

These data represent a 'snapshot' in time. Assessments were by phone and occurred over several days during the week of April 20-28, 2020. Case counts were as of Friday that week. Epidemiology Program data used for facility case counts (grey).
