The suspended culture of American Oysters (Crassostrea virginica) using OysterGro cages. Acadia Sea Farms plans to utilize upwards of 5,000 OysterGro cages and grow upwards of 5 million oysters per year during the new lease term.

In 2019, Acadia Sea Farms harvested approximately 400,000 oysters. The past three years Acadia Sea Farms stocked approximately 1,000,000 oyster seeds per year on the lease.
