4/1/2021	Indefinite	<u>Pirates Creek:</u> From the abandoned car on an unnamed point of Swards Neck (northeast of Pirates Creek) south to Hannah Miller Point to the adjacent subtidal.	Closed
3/27/2021	6/21/2021	<u>Mowery Beach:</u> West of a line beginning at the East tip of Mowery Point, then running East to the US/Canadian border to the navigational green can buoy#5, then to the Southwest wall of the Spark Plug(lighthouse), Then running West to a red painted post located on the shore at the end of Easy Street.	Closed
5/1/2021	12/15/2021	<u>Lawrence Factory/Birch Point:</u> From the point on the mainland across from Major Island southeast along the mainland to the southeast tip of Birch Point (north side of Birch Point Peninsula).	Closed
6/1/2021	1/15/2022	<u>Globe Cove:</u> West of a line beginning at a red painted post located on the shore of an unnamed point approximately 265 yards southeast from the rough boat landing on Cox Lane, then running northeast to the southeast tip of an unnamed point forming the north shore of Globe.	Closed
4/16/2021	6/21/2021	<u>Minzey Place:</u> South and west of a line beginning at a red painted post on the southeast tip of West Quoddy Bar, then running northeast to the western tip of a prominent spit of land located on the north shore of West Quoddy Head.	Closed
