06/24/2017	Indefinite	<u>Joy Bay- Steuben Harbor</u> : north of a line beginning at the southern tip of Baker Point then running east to the northern tip of Val Point. (Covers State Pollution Closure Area 52-G, A.1)	Closed
6/24/17	4/5/2020	<u>Joy Bay-Parritt Cove</u> : East of a line beginning at a red-painted post on the western tip of the unnamed point on the southern shore of Parritt Cove, then running northwest to the western tip of Parritt Point. (Covers State Pollution Closure Area 52-G, B.2)	Closed
06/24/17	Indefinite	<u>Pinkham Bay</u> : North of a line beginning at a red painted post located on the West shore of Pinkham Bay approximately 585 yards southwest of the Pinkham Bay Bridge then running east to an unnamed prominent point of land on the opposite shore; and west of a line beginning at the unnamed prominent point of land then running northeast to the westernmost tip of Hog Island, then running north to a red-painted post on the west end of the Pinkham Bay Bridge. (Covers State Pollution Closure Area 52-E, B.2)	Closed
10/31/15	Indefinite	<u>Dyer Harbor</u> : North of a line beginning at the southern tip of Goods Point and running northwest to the point of land at the end of Harbor Rd. (Covers State Pollution Closure Area 52-E, B.1.)	Closed
07/01/17	Indefinite	<u>Joy Bay</u> : East of a line beginning at a red painted post on the western tip of the unnamed point on the southern shore of Parritt Cove, then running northwest to the northwest tip of Parritt Point, then running north to the southwest tip of Val Point, then running northwest to a red painted post located on the west tip of Baker Point. Includes Steuben Harbor, north of a line beginning at the southern tip of Baker Point, then running east to the northern tip of Val Point.	Open
7/08/19	Indefinite	<u>Dyer Bay</u> : Parker Head, north of a line beginning at the shore at the end of Fickett Rd and running west approximately 250 yards to the southwest tip of land on the opposite shore. (Covers State Pollution Closure Area 52-E, B.3.)	Open

4/8/19	12/31/20	<u>Lewis Island to Stanley Point:</u> Inside of a line drawn from Lewis Island, so called, sitting east of Yeaton Cove, south to the north side of Stanley Point.	Closed
11/15/20	5/31/21	<u>Smelt Brook – Dyer Bay:</u> From the northwesterly point of Smelt Brook to the southeasterly point of Smelt Brook	Closed
9/19/20	6/25/21	<u>Goose Island:</u> From the point of land so-called Camp Cove North to a ledge with a blaze orange pin with the coordinates of N 44°28.823, W 067°54.910 then Northeast to the state pin at Missy Way.	Closed

6/15/20	11/15/20	<u>Pigeon Hill-</u> From the Pinkhenn Wharf East to the channel to the Steuben/Milbridge townline, then running North to the point of land Dividing the two towns.	Closed
