05/10/2016	5/31/2020	Mill Cove (designated as B.2. on DMR Pollution Area No. 21-E) - the entire cove to the west of Bailey Point, northeast of a line from the southern tip of an unnamed point on the west side and running southeast to a red pointed post on the eastern shore.	Closed
05/16/2018	05/16/2020	Brooks Cove and Blake cove – the entire area inside of a line beginning at a point of land at the southwestern end of Brooks Cove, running northeasterly to the southern end of Brooks Point, and continuing northeasterly along the shoreline, to the southern tip of the point of land on Blake Cove’s east side.	Closed
