
Access to the Intertidal

Historical


- Massachusetts Bay Colony—ownership to low tide to encourage trade
- Maine Statehood—changed intertidal to fishing, fowling and navigation
 - With large measure of local control and management
 - Shellfish license for commercial or recreational





 - Any problems are handled by the Shellfish Warden/Town





Corea Harbor

- Harbor infrastructure is at risk of flooding from freshwater flooding, sea level rise, and impacts from hurricanes.
- Increased sea level rise over time will create deeper flood waters and further inland flooding in Corea Harbor, threatening more properties and roads.

- Gouldsboro joined Maine's "Community Resilience Partnership"
 - "...Working to help Maine communities reduce emission and prepare for the effects of climate change..."
- Town "Coastal Resilience Committee"
 - focus on finding outside support for the engineering studies to address vulnerabilities identified
