Shellfish Harvesting Area Classification-Notification of Changes

November 21, 2022

This notice is in effect until repealed or replaced

Under the authority of 12 M.R.S.A. § 6172; the Commissioner has made the following change to Area No. 1000, Scallops (Maine Coast): This notice modifies the closure language to allow the landing of scallop shells in addition to scallop adductor muscles. This language change does **not** allow the landing of whole or intact scallops, scallop viscera or roe on scallops. All existing pollution and biotoxin closures remain in effect.

The boundary descriptions of the area are as follows (struck text is being removed and underlined text is being added):

- A. Effective immediately, because of biotoxin, it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess any species of scallops, including but not limited to *Placopecten magellanicus* and *Argopecten irradians*, whole or intact, or scallop viscera, taken from Maine coastal waters and those offshore waters of the exclusive economic zone (EEZ/200 mile limit) between the Maine/New Hampshire border and the Canadian border. Only the adductor muscle and scallop shells may be retained and landed for personal use, wholesale, or retail trade.
