CONCISE SUMMARY: The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission (ASMFC) Atlantic Menhaden Management Board approved a total allowable catch (TAC) for the 2017 fishing season of 200,000 mt. The amount allocated to Maine for 2017 is 171,882 lbs. States have the responsibility to close their directed commercial fisheries in their state once their quota has been reached. Based on its knowledge of existing fishing activity, Maine DMR is aware that the 2017 menhaden quota has been reached, and is closing the menhaden fishery for 2017 in order to avoid unusual damage and imminent depletion of the menhaden resource. The Commissioner adopts this emergency rule-making under the authority provided by 6171-3 (A).

41.30 Menhaden Program

1. State Allocation Fishery
It is unlawful to fish for, take, or possess Atlantic menhaden.

Basis Statement

The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission Atlantic Menhaden Management Board approved a total allowable catch (TAC) for the 2017 fishing season of 200,000 mt. The TAC is made available to the states based on the allocation established by Amendment 2 to the Interstate Fisheries Management Plan for Atlantic menhaden. The amount allocated to Maine for 2017 is 171,882 lbs. States have the responsibility to close their directed commercial fisheries in their state once their quota has been reached. Based on its knowledge of existing fishing activity, Maine DMR is aware that the 2017 menhaden quota has been reached, and is closing the menhaden fishery for 2017 in order to avoid unusual damage and imminent depletion of the menhaden resource. The existing chapter is repealed and replaced with a prohibition on fishing for, taking, or possessing Atlantic menhaden. The Commissioner adopts this emergency rule-making under the authority provided by 6171-3 (A).
