Instructions for Harvester Catch Form H2018A

A. Header Information:

- Harvester Name: Print name legibly as it appears on your license.
- State Landings #: Enter your state landings number (located in the upper left of your license).
- **Phone:** Enter a phone number where you may be reached if we have questions about information on your form.
- Send More Logbooks: Check box if you need more forms.
- Vessel Name: Enter name of boat (if applicable).
- CG# or State Reg #: Enter state vessel registration number or Coast Guard documentation number of boat (if applicable).
- Year: Enter year of harvest
- Month: Enter month of harvest. Use one form per month for positive reporting. You can use one form to submit multiple negative reports (did not fish).
- **B.** <u>License Selection</u>: Check the box for <u>all the license(s)</u> you are reporting for on this form for the month and year written in the top right corner. This should be done if this is a positive report where you will be putting your fishing activity, as well as if this is a negative report (if you did not fish for that species for the month).

C. <u>Positive Report Information</u>: If you did attempt to harvest marine species, fill out the following:

Note: <u>Use separate lines for each change in gear type, area fished, species, dealer/use, or port landed</u>. Do not fill out data for days you are only setting out gear; only record the days when you actively fished, even if you did not catch anything. If you report for multiple fisheries, put all catches for one month on one form. Please do not submit partial months of landings unless you are done fishing for the year.

- **Date:** Enter the harvest date.
- # Of Crew: Number of crew, including the captain. If you harvested with another licensed person who is also reporting this catch, put your individual catches and efforts on separate forms; do not each send in the total amount you caught together, as this would result in double reporting. When you split your catches, put the crew as 1.
- Gear Type: Use the gear code list provided to select the code for the type of gear used (See Table 1).
- Gear Quantity: Enter the quantity of gear used; if you are hauling pots/traps, enter the number of traps hauled that day (e.g., if you used 2 fyke nets, enter 2 here; if you hauled 300 traps, enter 300 here). See Attachment 1 for explanation.
- # Of Sets: Enter the number of sets, tows, dives or strings hauled. See Attachment 1 for explanation.
- Set Time: Check the box under "h" if your set time is reported in hours, "m" if it is in minutes, and "d" if it is in days. Enter the average time per set, tow, dive or total soak time for strings hauled.
- Total Gear In Water: Enter the total amount of gear that you had in the water on that day. Skip this if you skipped Gear Quantity above.
- **Depth:** Check the box to the right of "FA" if you are reporting in fathoms, or the box next to "FT" if you are reporting in feet. Enter the average depth of the gear (if applicable).
- Total Buoys Fished: Enter the total number of end lines you had in the water that day.
- Area fished: See Attachment 2 for requirements by fishery.
- Sea Time (Hrs.): Estimate the total harvest time in hours, including travel to and from the harvest location.
- Species (& Hal Length): Using the code list provided (See Table 3), enter the code for the type of species caught, including bycatch. If you made an effort to harvest, but did not catch anything, put NO CATCH here. *Seaweed harvesters:* after the species code, include the letter "A" if the seaweed was attached or "D" if it was detached. *Halibut harvesters:* after the species code, enter the length of the halibut caught. Record all fish on separate lines, including sub-legal fish that were caught and released. *Lobster harvesters:* only include those species that are landed.
- Pounds: Enter the estimated pounds of the catch in its landed condition or whole weight if it is an at-sea discard. <u>Seaweed harvesters:</u> enter wet pounds. <u>Lobster harvesters:</u> please include all harvested lobster and crab weights separately. <u>Scallop harvesters:</u> please record meat weights.
- Dealer Land # Or Use Code: If you sold the catch to a dealer, enter the dealer's landings number here. If you did not sell to a dealer, enter the use code (See Table 2) to define the fate of the catch. If you held the catch from multiple trips before selling it to the dealer indicated, put "*" next to the dealer's landings number to indicate it was not sold that day, but held over (or carred) and then sold at a later date.
- Port Landed (Town): Enter the port where catch was landed. For intertidal species (eel & seaweed): enter the town where the species was harvested. If you harvested in different towns on the same day, use separate lines for each town.

D. Signature: Sign.

- E. <u>Comments</u>: If you harvest species, use a gear or have a use code that is not included on these lists, or did not fish, note it here.
- F. Reports are due monthly by the 10th of the following month. All information reported to the DMR is protected by

 $12\ M.R.S.A\ \$6173$ and Chapter 5 regulation.


