Licenses may be issued starting July 1, 2025, or next business day, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C. The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.
