## 1. Bird Deterrents

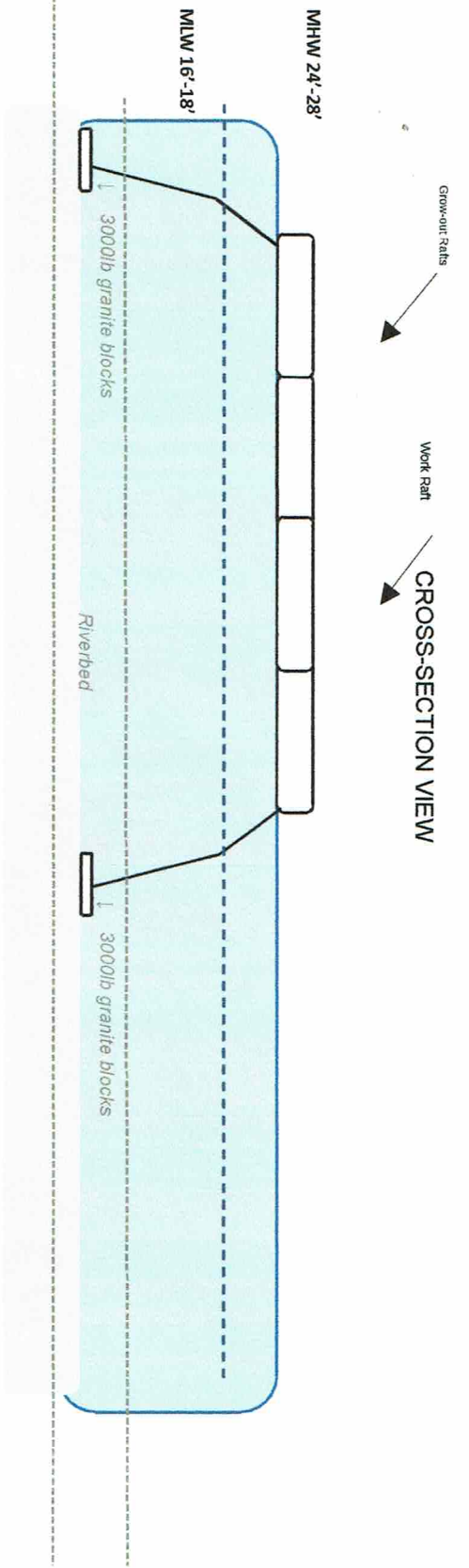

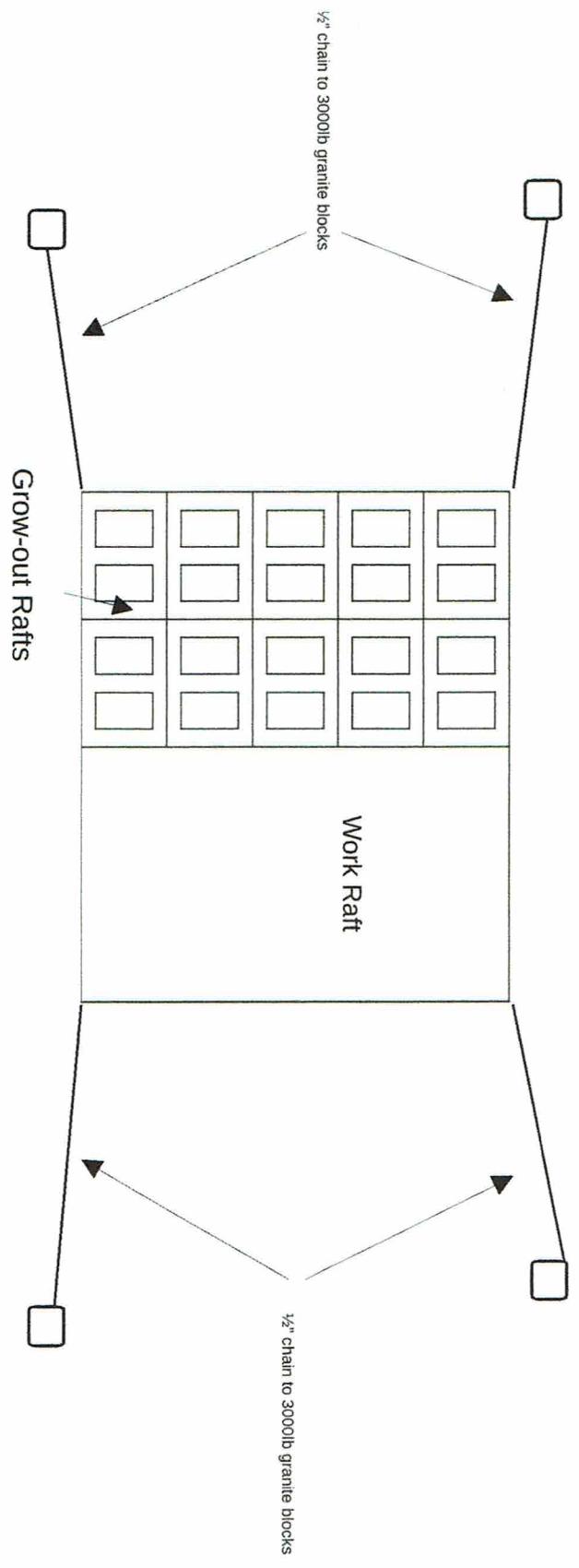

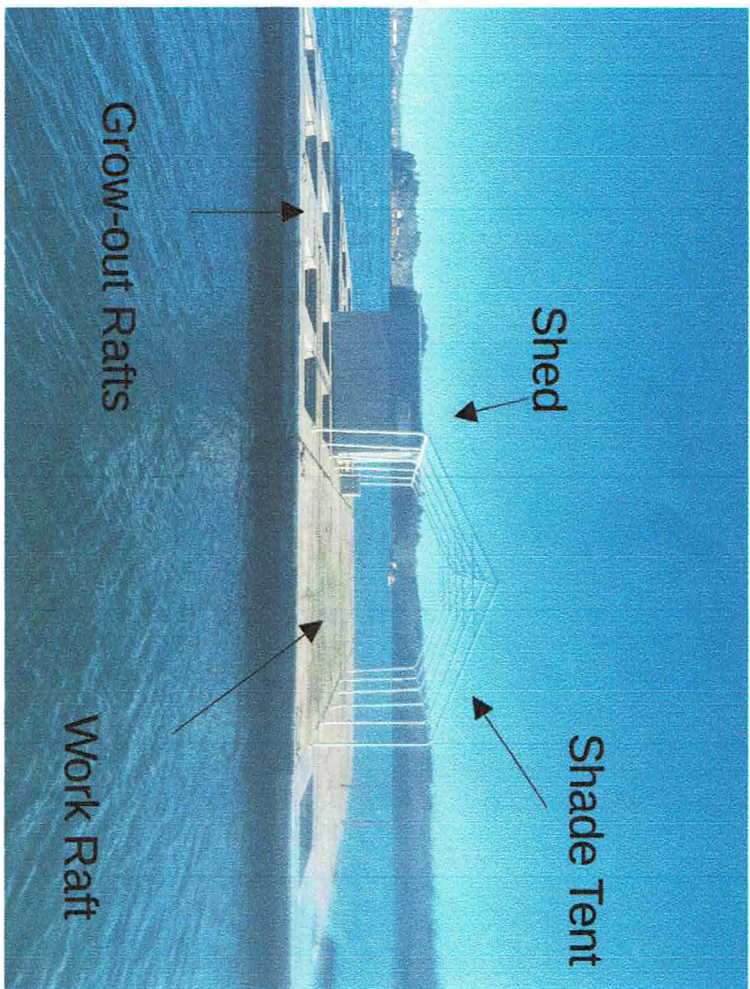
