 Describe the type and amount of aquaculture to be conducted during the new lease term:

During the new lease term, we will continue to grow oyster seed from hatchery to near market size with surface culture. We occasionally harvest hard clams from scuba and snorkel under the cages on the lease bottom. We buy 2 million oyster seed at 2mm every May and grow then to 1-3" before relaying them to JOHN NB3. We manage 3 connected floats, 3 boats, 2-6 employees and we manage longlines of oyster grow 6 pack cages and Flip Farm Hexcyl Baskets yearround. We request a 20 year term.

Describe the amount of aquaculture conducted on the lease site during the previous lease term, including but not limited to seeding, cultivation or harvest of organisms:

During our previous lease term we gave up on bottom culture after the oyster drills consumed all of the oysters. We are transitioning from wire oyster grow cages to plastic Flip Farm baskets in the same footprint with the same longlines. Last season, after the noncompliance letter, I relocated the lease boundary anchors and revamped the longlines so that all of the surface gear would remain in the lease boundaries during all tidal stages. Currently, the lease is marked with yellow sea farm bouys meeting USACOE requirements. Dec-Mar oyster gear is wintering on the river bottom, rafts and boats are removed until April when we raise Oyster Gro Cages and replace air caps, Flip Farm 12 liter floats are replaced and all gear (floats & boats) by May 1st. May-Nov, we manage this site Mon - Friday 7-5 and weekends Jun- Aug. Around the 20th of May, we purchase 1-2 million seed oysters from local hatcheries. We systematically air dry gear on longlines biweekly and tumble monthly to sort and restock with similar sized oysters. We operate a hydraulic tumbler, wash down hose, under a shade tent and grow oysters in stackable cages on the raft complex where we also air dry the same gear when not in use.

This lease site is a nursery farm only. We would reserve the right to harvest if our other lease was closed due to PSP. The oysters grow in wire cages and Flip Farm baskets. We systematically tumble with FIFO inventory, the largest are retained in stackable cages in the raft complex. These oysters will be relayed to JOHN NB3, they are the most protected from bird waste pollution because they are 2' below the water surface covered by 2" solid hatch doors. After 7-21 days on the rafts, they are transported by boat to Johns River where they are retumbled and restocked in similar rafts with bird protection ie roofs, wooden hatches and the deck is washed down twice daily. The product is held in JOHN NB3 for 3 weeks - 3 years and harvested under HACCAP, dealer, bulk, Vibrio, regulations and my brand has not been linked to any public health infections although we have sold more than 600,000 oysters per season over the past 6 years.

We grow oysters in floating cages, occasionally birds roost and defecate on cages and oysters are just under the surface filtering water, this can cause Campylobbacteria; Because this is possible, all pre market oysters are removed from floating gear (flip farm & oyster gro) and put into stackable cages in the shellfish rafts for several weeks to purge. For 3 years' time all DAM BN oysters are relocated to another lease for weeks, months and years prior to selling. My custom raft grow method protects oysters from birds because these pre mkt oysters are 1 foot underwater, 2 feet below raft deck height & beneath a solid 2" wooden hatch. This prevents any bird waste contamination. This has passed wet storage inspection and been viewed by kohl Kanwit.




