The DMR has received completed standard lease applications for the following:

<p>Applicant Name: Clam Hunter Seafood, Inc. Application Type: Two standard applications Culture Type: Suspended Culture of Shellfish</p> <p>Application I: Location: Spirit Pond, Phippsburg Acreage and Term Requested: 2.52 Acres for 20 years</p> <p>Application II: Location: Mill Pond, Phippsburg Acreage and Term Requested: .96 Acres for 20 years</p>

The next step in the review process are required site visits. DMR scientists will visit the proposed lease sites and assess the areas in consideration of applicable lease decision criteria. After the site reviews are complete, site reports will be published and posted to DMR's website. Public hearings will then be scheduled. Public hearings are an opportunity for members of the public to provide testimony and evidence about the proposals as it relates to the criteria DMR must legally consider in evaluating standard leases. At this juncture, DMR is unable to estimate when public hearings will be scheduled but notices of the proceedings will be provided in accordance with applicable law.
