<p>1. Describe the type and amount of aquaculture to be conducted during the new lease term:</p> <p>The farm will be continuing with American Oysters in the same quantity that we have in the last few years (Roughly 200,000-400,000). During the new lease term we do not plan to exceed our capability to reach 1.5 million oysters. The lease has also been approved for the cultivation of Marine Algae for species including Sugar Kelp (<i>Saccharina latissimi</i>), Skinny Kelp (<i>Saccharina angustissima</i>), and Winged Kelp (<i>Alaria esculenta</i>). A maximum of 20,000 feet of grow lines with the minimum of 100 sporophytes per foot of seed string=1M organisms.</p>

2. Describe the amount of aquaculture conducted on the lease site during the previous lease term, including but not limited to seeding, cultivation or harvest of organisms:

Harp DH lease is currently being used to cultivate American Oysters (*Crassostrea virginica*). In addition, the lease has been approved for the cultivation of marine algae such as Sugar kelp (*Saccharina latissimi*), Skinny Kelp (*Saccharina angustissima*), and Winged kelp (*Alaria esculenta*). The lease has cultivated on average around 200,000-400,000 oysters per year. We receive our seed of roughly 125,000 oysters per year in late June to early July.

3. Suspended culture gear can attract birds that roost on the gear and defecate, potentially creating a pollution source impacting shellfish held within gear. In order to comply with the National Shellfish Sanitation Program (NSSP) Model Ordinance (MO), if the lease site is permitted for the culture of shellfish in suspended gear, please include a description of mitigation or deterrent measures to minimize the potential pollution impacts of birds at the lease site. If appropriate, include Sketches or photos that clearly depict those measures put into practice.

Examples may include:

- Suspended gear submerged at depth sufficient to deter roosting for at least two weeks before harvest
- Attaching physical deterrents (i.e. zip ties) to gear
- The lease site is used to culture shellfish seed only
- Only adductor-only shellfish are cultured on the lease site

Physical deterrent: An OysterGro Hawk Kite system on a stick is located on a moored cage to the south of the Oyster lease
Oysters are submerged two weeks prior to harvest.


