Describe the type and amount of aquaculture to be conducted during the new term: 3.

The Eastern Oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*) is the only species that will be grown. Source of the seedstock include Muscongus Bay Aquaculture (Bremen, ME), Pemaquid Oyster Company (Waldoboro, ME) and Mook Sea Farm (Walpole, ME). Each student receiving 250 seed, at about 15mm in size. We anticipate having 10 students in the program and they will be with us in the program for up to 2 years. The site is used March 1 through December 30th and the oysters are wintered either in cold storage or at our Dodge Pt LPA.

The oysters are grown on Rebar tables ('oyster tables' or 'trestles') about 15 feet from the shore and standard shellfish growing bags (no floats or bridles needed) will be attached to these. The tables will be approximately 6' in length, and each will hold up to 4 bags. Approximately 15 tables are anticipated on the lease site. Tables will be of a single level, and will sit approximately 6" to 12" above the sediment surface. Harvest for the oysters consists only of removing them from their growing bags. Approximately 4,000 to 6,000 oysters will be on this site at any one time.

lease term, including but not to limited to seeding, cultivation or harvest of organisms:


We kept around 4-6,000 oysters on the site at any one time in the last least term. We obtained seedstock and grew them for up to 18 months before they were harvested by students.

The site will be used for educational purposes and field trial (growing species by means of a less common method, suspended from fixed tables in the near-shore area). As an educational program, the site is accessible by the Coastal Rivers and use it as a teaching tool for members and guests who are not necessarily part of the OG program. For example, we welcome many groups of children and young students to the property, and we can use the site as a way to teach material related to water quality, food production, multiple use of natural resources, management, and many other issues.
