*Note: Areas seeded with shellfish taken from Restricted (Closed) areas must be closed for a period of at least 60 days. Areas seeded with shellfish taken from Prohibited (Closed) areas must be closed for a period of at least 6 months. Check source flat water quality classification above.

**Note: Maximum seed sizes for shellfish are defined in DMR Regulation Chapter 2.95.
