
## **How to Report Carring Electronically**

## Reporting on VESL

If you keep your catch to sell later, you have "carred" it. When you do this, you need to report it differently. Your Catch Source should be marked as "CARRED" instead of "STANDARD" in your Species Details. When you add your Offload to your report, mark your Sale Disposition as "Sold to Dealer", and make the Date Sold the day that you actually sell to your dealer ("Date Sold" only applies to federal harvesters). The report may need to wait in "Pending" until you sell your catch, because the report will not submit with a sold date later than the day you submit the report. If you harvest on the day that you sell your catch, your Catch Source should be "STANDARD", even if you are selling carred catch in addition to what you caught that day. If you do not harvest on the day you sell all your catch, your report should be marked as "CARRED".

Example scenario: You catch 134 lbs on June 4, 200 lbs on June 5, and 157 lbs on June 6. You keep your catch on June 4 and June 5 and sell everything on June 6.



The offloads add up to 491 lbs, which is what the dealer will report. The reports show that you had catch on three days, carred for two days, and sold on the third day.

## Reporting on LEEDS

Enter your General, Effort, and Species Information as usual. When entering your Catch Information, mark the Catch Source as "Carred" on the days that you car your catch. If you sell your carred catch on a day that you also fished, mark Catch Source as "Trip".
