Dear Ms. Peabody,

We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocations for 2026, and hereby approve them as follows:

<i>Class</i>	<i>Subclass</i>	<i>Amount</i>	<i>Cost</i>
Commercial	Resident	No Limit Set	\$100
Commercial	Nonresident	10%	\$200
Recreational	Resident	No Limit Set	\$55
Recreational	Nonresident	10%	\$90
Recreational	Senior Resident	No Limit Set	\$0
Recreational	Senior Nonresident	10%	\$0

The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.

Licenses may be issued starting on June 16, 2026, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.
