The harvest season for 2025-2026 is 12/1/2025 – 4/30/2026.

Licenses may be issued starting on September 20, 2025, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C. For categories of licenses which have limited numbers for both residents and non-residents: after December 19, 2025, any unsold licenses must be made available without regard to residency (Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.) for the original allocated fee (DMR Chapter 7.40 (1)).
