A. Brian Beal, Ph.D.

Dr. Beal, a professor of marine ecology at the University of Maine at Machias, and director of the University's Marine Science Field Station, is the foremost authority on Maine's littoral zone. His C.V. is attached as Coffin Exhibit 10. He will testify to the absence of living eelgrass on the lease site and to flaws in the DMR Site Review.

He will testify that, provided the proposed lease area is modified in a manner to be presented at hearing, and provided certain buoy and buoy anchor specifications to be testified to are part of the lease requirements, the ship will be able to enter and leave the Bustins Island ramp safely.
