We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocations for 2025, and hereby approve them as follows:

The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.

Licenses may be issued starting on January 2, 2025, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C. As per the Town of Arrowsic Shellfish Conservation Ordinance, licenses issued after January 1, 2025 are to be made available regardless of residency.
