6/20/2024	6/20/2025	Freeport town line; Cousins River (WI) to the Freeport town line on Flying Point (WJ) closed for soft shell clam harvesting Sundays; and all nights 1/2 hour past sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise. All other ordinance species (hard clams, razor clams) closed to harvesting all nights 1/2 hour past sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise.	Closed to harvest of soft shell, quahog, and razor clam.
