Licenses may be issued starting June 1, 2026, or the next business day, following a minimum of 10 days of advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.

For license categories with limited numbers available for both residents and non-residents: after August 30, 2026, any unsold licenses must be made available without regard to residency (Title 12. §6671 3-A.C.), at the original allocated fee (DMR Chapter 7.40(1)).
