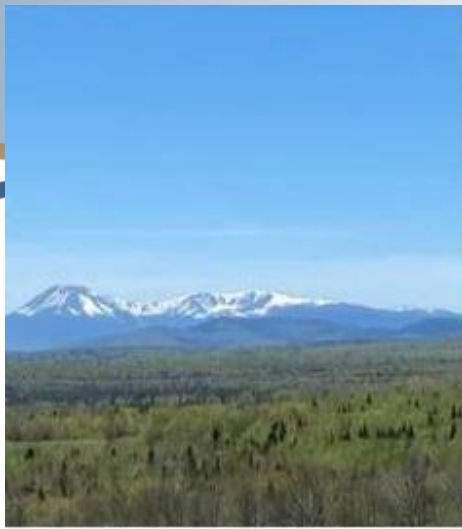

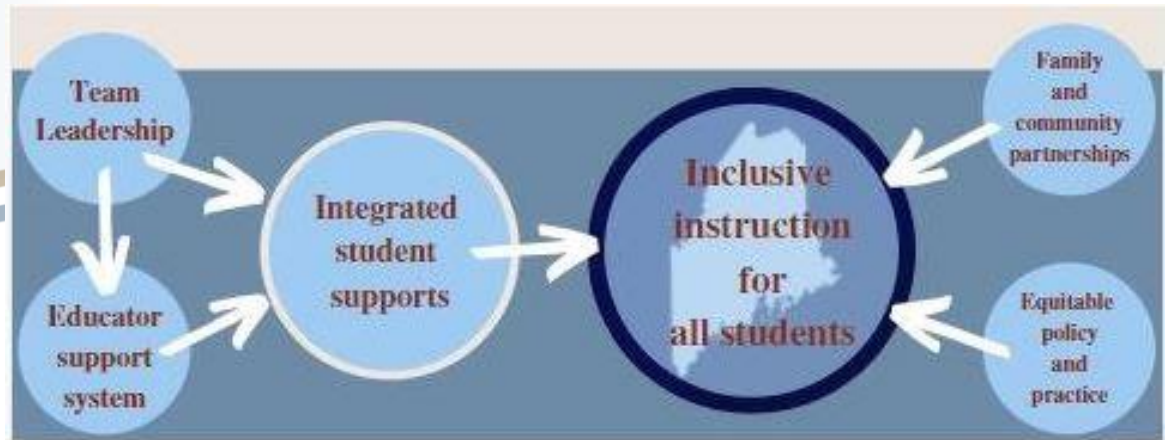

LGBT Student Health



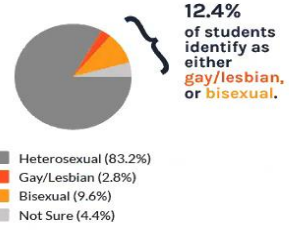
High school-level data from the 2019 Maine Integrated Youth Health Survey

LGBT (about 7,500).

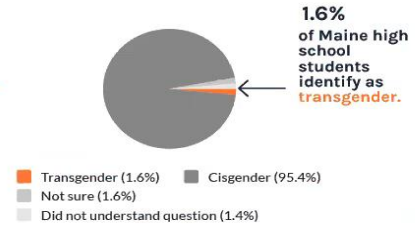
That's nearly 1 in 7 students.



Sexual Orientation



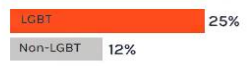
Gender Identity



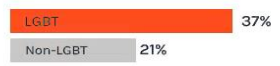
LGBT students experience more violence and discrimination at school, at home, and in the community.

to school because of:

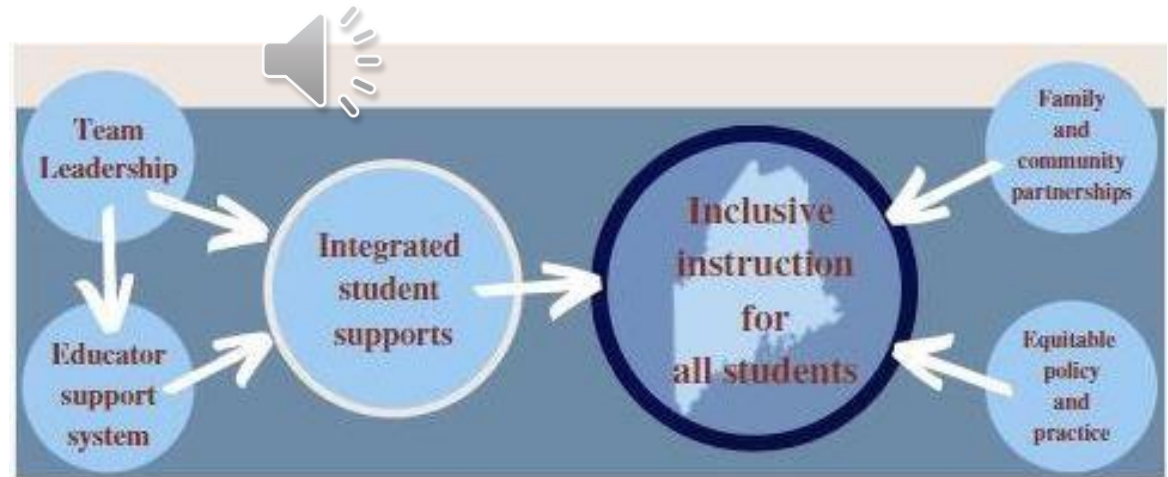
