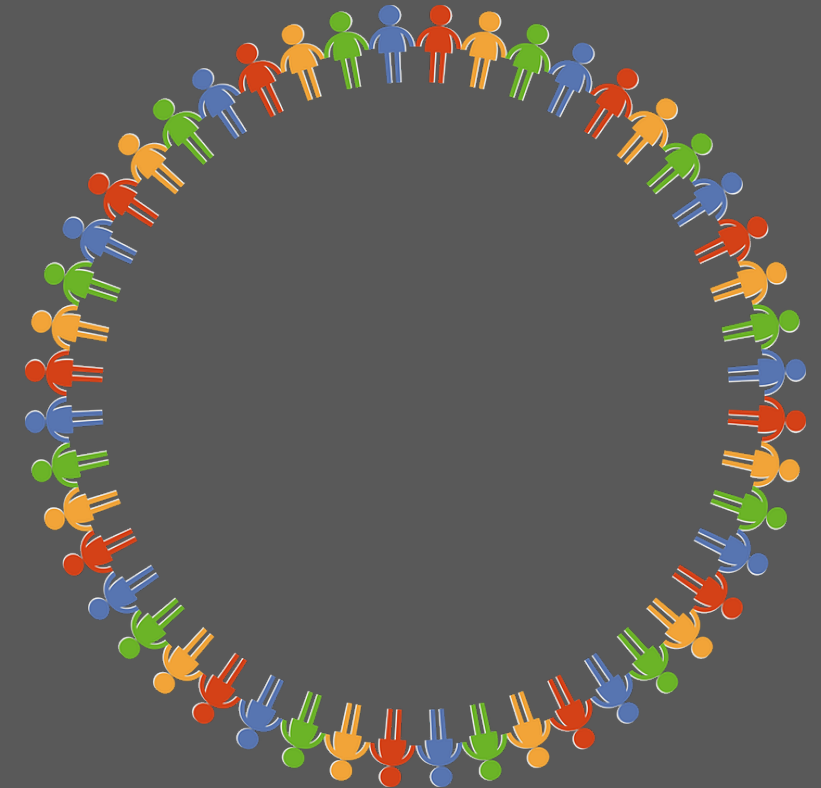


# MLTI 2.0 Software Advisory Group

To provide guidance / recommendations to the Maine DOE on how to fulfill the mission of MLTI 2.0 Software.



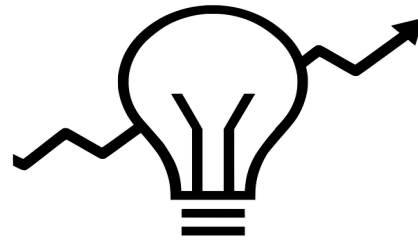
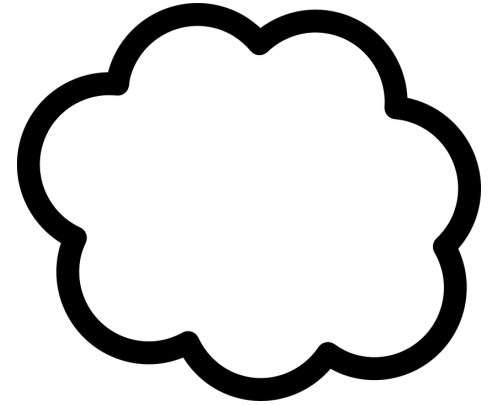
