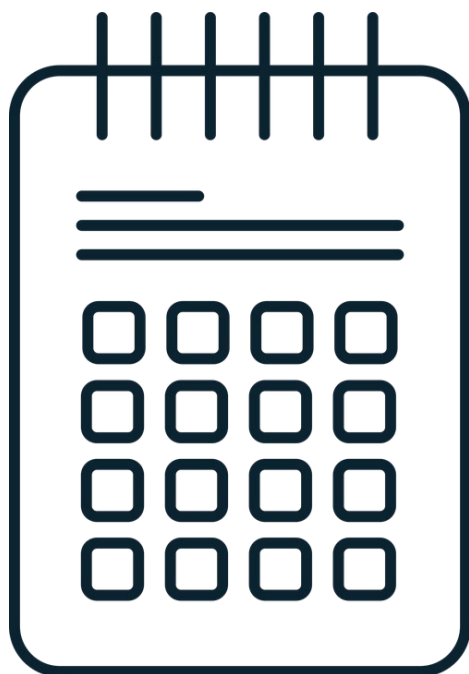

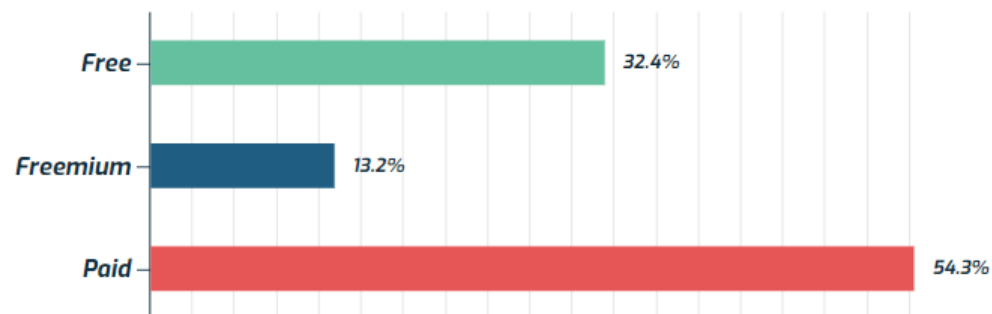
Current State

Paid

About 50% of the paid application pertain to core curricular content.

About 17% are applications are creation tools for students.



Freemium

43% of the freemium application where primarily instructional tools for teachers to help deliver content and another 17% were content related applications.

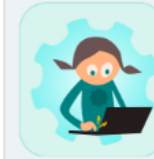
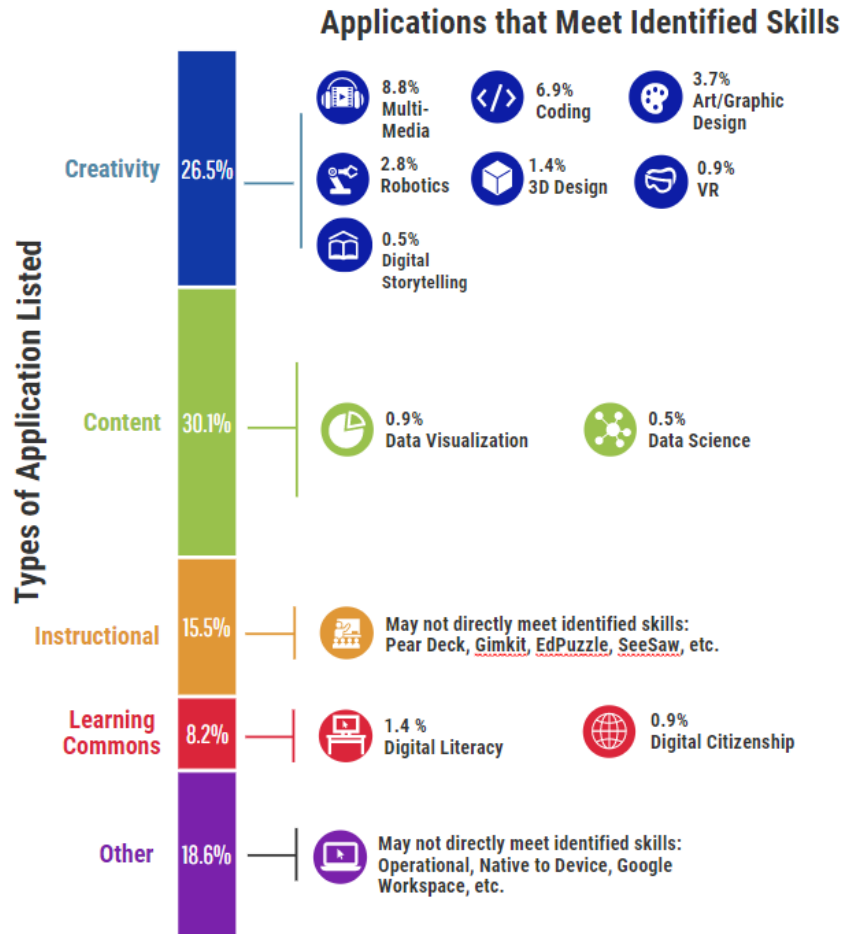
23% were creation tools for students.

Scratch could be used for this, but it does not really address game design.



AR/VR/AI

CoSpaces was the only VR creation application mentioned. There are a few robotics applications, but nothing specifically for AI.



Online Safety-Digital Etiquette

Common Sense Education was the only application mentioned.
