Types of Questioning Data Collection

Ask a colleague to observe your class and record the types of questions.

Gathering Information

Students recall facts, definitions, or procedures/processes

Probing Thinking

Students explain, elaborate, or clarify their thinking, including articulating the steps in solution methods or the completion of a task

Making the Learning Visible

Students discuss their learning and make connections among ideas and relationships

Encouraging Reflection and Justification

Students reveal deeper understanding of their reasoning and actions, including making an argument for the validity of their work
