## \$1.6 Million


For school year 2022-2023 Governor Mills provided an additional \$1.6 Million to CTE schools to assist in the increase costs of supplies to support CTE programming.

## \$20 Million MJRP Funding

\$15 Million to CTE Schools for program, equipment and facility upgrades, allowing CTEs to expand hands-on, real-world programs for Maine students in plumbing, welding, electrical, building construction, and more!

\$4.5 Million to CTE Schools to purchase and upgrade equipment to enhance student learning experiences and career preparation for high-skilled, in-demand industries! Funds also support increased personnel to assist with growing programs, allowing more students than ever to participate in CTE programs!
