

## Starting Seeds in Bags



### Materials

- 3 paper towels
- 1 small container of water
- 2 sandwich-size plastic bags
- 4 bean seeds

### Preparation

Spread one paper towel on the workspace to keep it clean and dry.

	<p><b>1.</b> Fold one paper towel to the size of your hand.</p> <p><b>2.</b> Dip your hand in the water.</p>		<p><b>5.</b> Place the paper towel flat inside a bag.</p>
	<p><b>3.</b> Put your hand on the folded paper towel to get it a little bit wet. Keep doing this until the paper towel is damp but not soaking wet.</p>		<p><b>6.</b> Place two beans on top of the paper towel inside the bag.</p> <p>Leave the bag open so air can circulate.</p>
	<p><b>4.</b> Fold the paper towel again so that it fits flat inside a plastic bag.</p>		<p><b>7.</b> Repeat this process with another bag and seeds. You will have two bags with two seeds in each.</p>
