

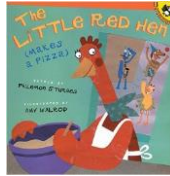


Let's Find Out About It: Markets Around The World

Materials:

- *Who Works in a Grocery Store?*
- photos of markets resource
- Images of local farmers markets

Vocabulary:

- market: a place where people buy and sell things
- purchase: buy
- sell: give something for money
- ingredients: things that are mixed together
- local: near to where you live

Preparation: Set up materials.

"Here are images of **markets** from a few places around the world. They also sell **ingredients** and supplies. What do you notice?"

"How are these **markets** similar to or different from **local**--nearby--supermarkets and grocery stores?"

"How are these jobs the same as or different from the jobs in *Who Works In A Grocery Store?*"
