GRADUATED: Student has completed an associate's, bachelor's or higher degree (certificates are not included). Once a student is counted as a graduate, $\mathrm{s} / \mathrm{he}$ is not counted again elsewhere in the report. A Graduated Record is reported before all other possible categories (e.g. New to College,Persisted, etc.)

NEW TO COLLEGE: First year that a student was found in the Clearinghouse database.

PERSISTED: Student was enrolled during the previous year and continues to be enrolled in the current year. The graphs show the student's continued enrollment at any postsecondary institution, not retention at the same institution.

RETURNED AFTER STOP OUT: Student was enrolled, did not appear in postsecondary education the following year, and reappeared in a year thereafter.
