FY21-22 Title I Schoolwide Authority

- For schools thinking about moving from a Targeted Assistance program to a Schoolwide program
- 40% Poverty Rate
- Planning should start at least 6-9 months ahead of submission
- Conduct comprehensive needs assessment and create schoolwide plan
- Apply by July 1st, 2021

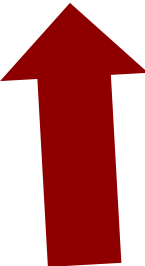

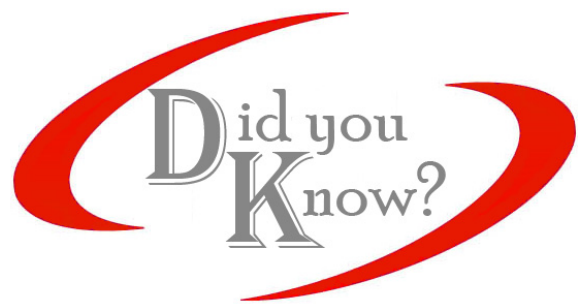
