

## American Rescue Plan (ARP) Homeless Children and Youth (HCY) Fund

The Maine Department of Education received over \$2.6 million in funding under the American Rescue Plan Act's Homeless Children and Youth (ARP-HCY) program to support students experiencing homelessness.

The Maine Department of Education will award 75 percent of the state's funding to SAUs through formula subgrants, determined in part by a district's population of children and youth experiencing homelessness and a district's Title I-A allocation. Accordingly, SAUs will not have to compete for these funds, so these funds will reach SAUs that may not have accessed previous federal funding designated for students experiencing homelessness. This will make it possible for states and SAUs to access funding more quickly and reach more students experiencing homelessness.

SAUs that do not meet the minimum threshold of \$5,000 for an award, based on the formula, should consider creating a consortium with other SAUs to receive a joint award.
