(NAEP) is a measurement of student achievement over time in the United States. NAEP is the largest nationally representative assessment of what students in every state know and can do in specific areas tested.

This assessment is a congressionally authorized project of the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) in the Elementary and Secondary Education Act legislation. From developing frameworks and questions to the reporting of results, NAEP represents the best thinking of assessment and content specialists, State education staff and teachers from around the nation.

NAEP Frameworks & Design



Each of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) assessments is based on an organizing framework. The Governing Board is responsible for developing both the framework and test specifications that serve as the blueprint for the assessment. The frameworks are devised through a development process that ensures they meet current educational requirements. The National Assessment Governing Board develops the NAEP frameworks for each subject.

Frameworks define the subject-specific content and thinking skills needed by students to deal with the complex issues they encounter in and out of the classroom. Assessments must be flexible and mirror changes in educational objectives and curricula. Therefore, the frameworks must be both forwardlooking and responsive, balancing current teaching practices with research findings. The NAEP frameworks are located <u>here</u>. Since the late 1980s, the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) has coordinated the United States' participation in international studies. These include the large-scale surveys comparing early childhood learning, student performance, teacher training and teaching, as well as adult skills.
