95% of attendees who submitted feedback indicated that the session content is usable and directly actionable and applicable to their current role.



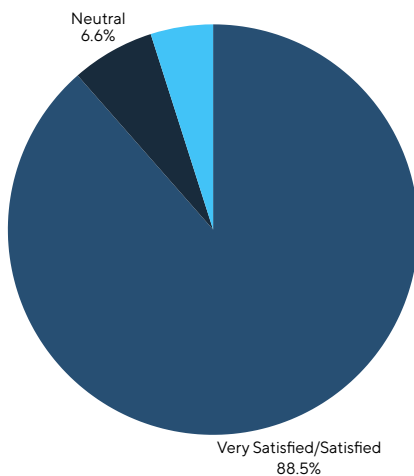
