The MSAA (ELA & math) and MSAA Science are Maine's alternate assessments based on alternate academic achievement standards, designed for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities who have been found eligible by the IEP Team utilizing state guidance resources. NAEP 2024 Reporting

The NAEP 2024 results are tentatively scheduled to be released in early 2025. There is no update to exactly when these results will be released. These data are held at the federal level. Several requests for Maine student performance data on NAEP 2024. Maine DOE does not have access to the data and is unable to fulfill any requests for NAEP 2024 results at this time. The National Assessment Governing Board and the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) will announce the date and plans for the upcoming release of the 2024 Mathematics and Reading Assessments once the plans are finalized.

As a reminder, school and student level performance data is not available for NAEP assessments.

Notable changes for future NAEP administrations:

- The transition to school devices will begin with the 2026 administration of the NAEP assessments. Schools with Windows and/or Chrome based devices will administer the NAEP in a similar manner as other state assessments.
- The NAEP 2026 Mathematics and Reading assessments have updated frameworks and new items.
- The NAEP 2028 Science assessment will be based on the updated NAEP 2028 Science Framework.

The Test Setup Window for ACCESS for ELLs and WIDA Alternate ACCESS has now begun and will last throughout your ACCESS test window.

The test setup function in <u>WIDA AMS</u> lets you view students and modify registrations. As you prepare for the upcoming ACCESS administration, you should now login to <u>WIDA AMS</u> and make sure your students are entered in the appropriate registrations.

Students that were imported into <u>WIDA AMS</u> via the Student Import File (Pre-ID file) have been automatically placed into generic registrations based on grade cluster and domain.

View Registrations To view and filter registrations in <u>WIDA AMS</u>, click the Manage Registrations tile on the landing page. Then, filter by the district and/or school from the site selector on the top right side of

the screen. Select the ACCESS for ELLs - 2024-2025 Registration Window and a list of registrations for those sites will display on the View Registration(s) tab.
