Questions

As the DAC, I could not find the place to enter the number of students. Is that only available to the principal?

For schools in SAUs that are not designated as small districts for NAEP, the principal must enter the information. DACs in small districts can be provided with access privileges to assist principals and/or school coordinators. Federal guidance restricts access to the student level information that will become visible beginning December 8th.

Do we NEED a School Coordinator entered if the principal is going to do that? We can have them entered a second time if needed.

If the principal would like to self-designate the school's NAEP school Coordinator, please have the principal click on the icon to the right of the principal's row, and then click the toggle to the left of where it says, "Principal is school coordinator" and then click Save.

If our District Tech coordinator will be handling anything onsite at both NAEP selected locations do we need to enter him as School Technology Coordinator?

This is not necessary unless the School Coordinator needs assistance with the required technology tasks. To allow the District Technology Director to serve in the role of School Technology Coordinator, the person needs to be designated at the school level as the School Technology Coordinator. This is similar to the reasoning in the response related to the DAC and school level access.
