

Assessment Dashboards

ESSA Dashboard

- Available to the public
- Specific to the ESSA requirements
- Focuses mostly on performance levels

Data Warehouse

- Available to internal users only
- Includes unsuppressed data
- Has performance levels, scale scores, and RIT
- Focused more on longitudinal data



Data Warehouse Assessment Dashboard

Who has access?

- Appropriate DOE and state users
- Superintendents
- SAU administrators designated by superintendents

What can be customized?

- Demographic and student groups filters
- Year over year or averages

What data is available?

- ELA, Math, Science, ACCESS
- RIT, Scale, performance, all domains of WIDA ACCESS

What is the level of granularity?

• State, county, SAU, school

Fall Administration: Important Dates

December 3: Fall 2025 Student Score Data File becomes available



Winter Administration: Important Dates

December 15: Acacia opens for pre-administration activities

January 5 – February 13, 2026: Winter administration window

February 23-27: SAU data cleanup

March 18: Last day to run Operational Reports for the winter administration (not including the Student Score Data File)

March 25: Winter 2026 Student Score Data File becomes available








Where will I find... the model designation?








School Device Application Installer


Purpose: deploys the NAEP Assessment application to school devices

- Safelisting URLs
- Identifying devices to be used for the assessment
- Install and verify the NAEP Assessment application

Can be identified now

- Required for all schools assigned to the school devices model (M/R)
 - Receives an <u>automatic email</u> with instructions upon identification in AMS
 - Email can be added and/or resent on the School Team tile or on the SAU page by deleting and readding the contact information
 - Application Installer does not have AMS access










NAEP 2026 – How do I assign... a School Coordinator?





- Identify School Coordinators (primary point of contact for the NAEP assessment).
- Complete Grade Information Questions (prior to November 1, 2025).
- Respond to designated grade information questions prior to the student list submission.
- **Review Device Technical Requirements** (for schools identified for school device administration)
- **Identify an Application Installer** (if not already identified in the AMS).
- Add the scheduled NAEP Assessment Date to the School Calendar
- Field representatives will begin outreach to schools in December
- Review list of students selected for NAEP
- Assessment administration January 26, 2026 March 20, 2026
