1/29/26	Voluntary participation date for multilingual learners who are newly enrolled/identified	Newly identified MLs are not required to participate in ACCESS or Alternate ACCESS if the Maine ML Start Date (via state enrollment) falls less than 30 days within the close of the ELP assessment window, based on federal provision of up to 30 calendar days for LEAs (in Maine, SAUs) to screen students for potential ML status. It's important to note that schools have the option for these students to participate in ACCESS. It is recommended this decision be made as an instructional team, and that the parents are informed about the uses of the data and consulted in the decision-making process.	1/29/26
