OBJECTIVES TO BE COMPLETED BY THE STUDENT LEARNER: DRIVES TRUCK WITH CAPACITY OF MORE THAN 3 TONS, TO TRANSPORT MATERIALS TO AND FROM SPECIFIED DESTINATIONS: DRIVES TRUCK TO DESTINATION, APPLYING KNOWLEDGE OF COMMERCIAL DRIVING REGULATIONS AND AREA ROADS. PREPARES RECEIPTS FOR LOAD PICKED UP. COLLECTS PAYMENT FOR GOODS DELIVERED AND DELIVERY CHARGES. MAY MAINTAIN TRUCK LOG, ACCORDING TO STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS. MAY MAINTAIN TELEPHONE OR RADIO CONTACT WITH SUPERVISOR TO RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS. MAY LOAD AND UNLOAD TRUCKS. MAY INSPECT TRUCK EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES SUCH AS TIRES, LIGHTS, BRAKES, GAS, OIL, AND WATER. MAY PERFORM EMERGENCY ROADSIDE REPAIRS, SUCH AS CHANGING TIRES, INSTALLING LIGHT BULBS, TIRE CHAIN, AND SPARK PLUGS. MAY POSITION BLOCKS AND TIE ROPE AROUND ITEMS TO SECURE CARGO DURING TRANSIT. WHEN DRIVING TRUCK EQUIPPED FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES , SUCH AS TYPE OF TRUCK DRIVER, FLATBED (LOGGING). MAY BE DESIGNED ACCORDING TO KIND OF CARGO TRANSPORTED.
