### **Definitions**

- Child A student in high school grade or under enrolled in an educational unit of high school or under....
  (7 CFR §210.1)
- Student Eligibility -
  - A person who will be five years old on October 15 of the school year may enroll in school
  - A person who will be at least four years old on October 15 of the school year may enroll in a public preschool program, if offered (State of Maine Title 20-A: Chapter 213: §5201)



### **Definitions**

- Local Education Agency (LEA) public board of education...or a public or private nonprofit institution or agency having administrative control and direction of a public or private nonprofit [school] (7 CFR §210.1)
- School Administrative Unit (SAU) A state-approved unit of school administration (State of Maine Title 20-A: Chapter 1)
- The LEA/SAU has administrative authority over a school
  - Determined by the organization ID # that <u>can be found on the Maine DOE</u> website.



### **Definitions**

- School
  - (1) An educational unit of <u>high school grades or under</u>, <u>recognized as part of</u> the educational system in the State ...
  - (2) Any public or nonprofit private classes of pre-primary grade when they are conducted in the aforementioned schools...
  - (3) Residential child care institution (7 CFR §210.1)



### **Situations**

- There is a "program" nearby and you are being asked to feed the students.
- Such as...
  - Regional program
  - Alternative education program
  - Pre-K program



### Meals can only be served and claimed for reimbursement by a SAU when...









Students are enrolled in the SAU, and

the meal is consumed at a school building in that SAU, and

it is an in-person academic school day, and

in a congregate setting.






#### **Public Pre-K**

To participate in the NSLP:

- the pre-K program must be in a building on school grounds that is under the legal authority of an SAU.
- Students must be four years of age on October 15 of the school year or a three-yearold with an IEP.
- Students must be enrolled in and in regular attendance at the public pre-K program.





## Career & Technical Education (CTE)

If the CTE school participates in the NSLP/SBP and students attend the CTE school during the part of the school day that includes meal service, the CTE school may feed and claim the students in attendance.

F/R eligibility is determined by the sending school where the student is enrolled.





# Career & Technical Education (CTE)

If the CTE school does not participate in the NSLP/SBP, the sending school may provide a reimbursable take-out meal that meets program requirements <u>for only their enrolled students that attend</u> the CTE school.





### **Field Trips**

Occasional school-sponsored events occurring during the school day. Meals may be sent for students and claimed for reimbursement if:

- Meal pattern requirements are met
- Meals are documented on the food production record
- Lunches are served between the hours of 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- Meals are counted and documented by staff the complete meal is distributed to students. This is referred to as "point of service."
- Only meals served to students may be claimed.
- Appropriate food safety practices must be followed



### **Key Considerations for Serving Meals "Off-site"**

- Are the students enrolled in your SAU?
- Is the program in a school building on the school campus?
- Is the site where they are attending part of the SAU or is it under the legal authority of another entity?
