Dear Superintendent Lyons:

The Fayette Public Schools Nutrition Program was reviewed per Federal Regulation 7CFR 210.18 and Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition policies and procedures. On December 18, 2024 Sarah Platt reviewed Fayette Central School. An exit conference occurred with you on December 18, 2024.

The enclosed Official Notification of Review Findings and Corrective Action describes the corrective action documentation required. Please submit a detailed response for each of the review findings listed in the report by the deadline(s) listed. Responses must be submitted through CNPweb, Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition's Administrative Review software, and must address the following:

- How the finding was corrected (include who, when & how)
- Documentation that the finding has been corrected district-wide
- How this action will ensure future compliance

In accordance with §210.18(k), failure to return completed documentation within 30 days from the corrective action deadline date will result in the withholding of reimbursement payments. We hope that following the exit conference you and your staff addressed the corrective actions and that you will have no problems in meeting the response deadline.

The Official Notification also provides the potential fiscal action, which is an initial estimate of the amount of reimbursement that will be reclaimed. These are only estimates which must be adjusted to the actual date of corrective action for each violation. If documentation of corrective action or acceptable corrective action is not received by the response date stated above, the claim will be recalculated to the end of the school year.

Finding 9000: Unallowable Meal Count Procedure

Tray counts are being used to count reimbursable meals which is an unallowable method. Meals are tracked by counting the starting and ending number of trays and recording the difference. Trays served to adults are subtracted. Based on observation, the reviewer does not feel that counts are inaccurate however program regulations require that meal counts be taken at the point when the student receives their complete meal. This includes the use of a clicker or tic sheet, or students placing an object such as their ID card in a basket at the point of service.

Corrective Action:

Implement a meal count system that counts complete meals at the point when the student receives the complete meal. Upload a description of the system in CNPweb --> E-reviews --> Corrective Action Responses by **January 24**, **2025**.
