USDA Food program

- The USDA program began during the Great Depression in the early 1930's.
- There was massive unemployment and hunger.
- Farms suffered from surpluses because people had no money to buy their goods.
- As a result, crops and livestock ended up having to be destroyed because no one could afford to buy them.
- In 1933, the first of many laws was established by Congress with creation of the Federal Surplus Commodities Corporation, later to be called the Commodity Credit Corporation-(CCC).
- This created loans for farms and price support for excess crops and livestock. Because times were financially very difficult, the government allowed for loan payments to be in the form of crops.
- These crops were donated to newly created domestic and international outlets, including the National School Lunch program-(NSLP)

What is PAL

- Planned Assistance Level
- PAL Entitlement is based on number of lunches claimed during the 'previous' school year x meal rate .45



How to use your PAL money

- USDA Foods purchase cases
- NOI (Net off Invoice) purchase raw pounds
- DOD (Department of Defense) / FFAVORS purchase fresh fruits and vegetables
- NOI and DOD are optional



What is the USDA Food Annual Survey

- When school districts purchase their USDA food items for the 'following' School Year.
- For SY2024-2025 the Annual Survey opened on February 12, 2024, and closed on March 8, 2024.
- The previous directors did the planning for you
- The Annual Survey comes out in the winter
 - watch the Thursday update for instructions



What needs to be done next

- View Annual Survey in CNPweb
- Place monthly orders
- Monthly orders are due 1-15th of each month



How to view your Annual Survey

- Log into CNPweb
- Select: FDP= Food Distribution Program
- Select Program Year: 2025
- Locate Sponsor name by clicking on the 1st letter of your sponsor name/districts.
 Note: There are no districts listed as 'AOS' or 'Union'
- Click on the Sponsor "number"
- Takes you to the Sponsor Summary page. **Blue tabs**: Applications, Entitlement, Surveys, Allocations, Inventory and Orders
